OLYMPIADES

Our Olympiads provide teams with an opportunity to rotate through a number of exciting and challenging activities, including archery; giant skis; DVA research; GPS transceivers; slalom Skyver scooters; 1m-long brush masterpiece painting; cut-the-log; the Blind Course; hockey; Rough Golf; and more. A winter version can be organized if snow conditions permit. Olympiad teambuilding activities are suitable for everyone, and huge fun.



DESCRIPTION

Olympiads present varied and engaging challenges, allowing all individuals and teams to complete and really enjoy themselves, while learning to work as part of a team. We vary the number and type of activities according to the size of groups.

TARGETS

The teambuilding provided by the Olympiads helps construct strong bonds between participants, through a variety of fun, sporting and cultural activities.

KEY ELEMENTS

Group cohesion; fun atmosphere; individual and group performance; and great competition.

CONSTRUCTION AND RACING OF HAND-MADE RAFTS/SLEDS

activities involving construction and racing of rafts and sleds are one of our signature teambuilding challenges. It will ignite your teams' competitive fire as they work together to build and make their very own makeshift rafts - or sleds during the snowy days - working hard to make their constructions sufficiently robust, and aiming to be the first across the line. The crystal-clear lakes of the Alps are our preferred location, but we have used pools and lakes in many other locations for this engaging activity.

DESCRIPTION

Teams are given a set time to construct and test their raft or sled, and prepare for the race. They have a limited set of supplied materials at their disposal: bouyancy elements, wooden components, ropes, sails and paddles. Teams need to work within specific constraints and must strive hard to achieve integrity and durability in their designs.

TARGETS

Everyone can, and should be, actively involved throughout. Team members must collaborate effectively to build their structures and get them moving. The task is an excellent development and test of ingenuity, creativity, and problem-solving.

KEY ELEMENTS

Insights into self and working with others. Task allocation and collaboration; creativity and ingenuity; team work and mutual confidence.

ALL YEAR ROUND

RAID ADVENTURE

A 'raid' is a multi-sport activity designed around 'missions' which put teams through tough physical challenges. Missions are formed of combined activities, tailored to specific needs and customized for all fitness levels. Extreme sports can replace 'suitable-for-all' activities to match specific needs and objectives. The winter version can include snowshoe activities and other snowsports.

DESCRIPTION

A 'raid' is a combination of challenging outdoor activities – trekking; archery; kayaking... Each team's goal is to complete a point-to-point course in the shortest time, using maps, navigation aids, and more.

TARGETS

The 'raids' combine problem-solving and strategy, putting team together in demanding and rewarding environments. They support development of collective, supportive effort in achieving a common goal.

KEY ELEMENTS

Cross-event application; group cohesion; individual & group confidence-building; task sharing; navigation; focus & speed; competitive attitude; and decision-making.



LOCATION

This event can be organized in any location.

ORIENTEERING RALLY

This teambuilding activity takes teams through complex orienteering tasks in demanding outdoor settings. The team must develop an effective strategy, and learn to make the very best use of maps, clues, compasses, and GPS transceivers. The activity includes 'on-the-go' challenges, increasing excitement and engagement. We can vary this activity in dozens of ways – itinerary, duration, environment, by day or night – to suit client requirements and to match the seasonal conditions.

LOCATION

DESCRIPTION

Orienteering involves all team members fully, planning the itinerary, navigating and solving problems. It engages everyone interested in way-finding and enhancing team working.

AVALANCHE AWARENESS EXPERIENCE

The mountains have their objective dangers. However, the risks can be minimized significantly by making well-informed decisions about which terrain is safe, in contrast to that which is unstable and dangerous. Our IFMGA guides are experts in mountain travel and in introducing people to risk-mitigation in the Alpine environment. This safety-focussed programme will teach you awareness of mountain conditions, effective use of specialist equipment – including transceivers, probes and shovels, and how to test snow conditions to assess risk levels before venturing onto snow-laden slopes.

DESCRIPTION

It is essential for survival in the high mountain environment to have up-to-date avalanche training. This programme is run by our team of fully qualified IFMGA-UIAGM mountain guides who, as well as being experts on off-piste itineraries, are also passionate skiers and mountaineers.

TARGETS

Through hands-on activities and authentic experiences, participants can develop problem-solving skills, resilience and collaboration – all in a potentially hostile mountain environment.

KEY ELEMENTS

Effectiveness in understanding and applying instructions and following critical guidelines. Team participation; management of stress; acquisition of specialist knowledge; persistence.

THE GREAT ALCATRAZ ESCAPE

This event provides participants with amusing yet engaging immersion in an imagined context – but played out through exciting activities in the mountains. Based around the theme of escape, it involves convict uniforms, loss of orientation, avoiding main roads, decision-making... and even police patrols! The event starts with the escape of participating ‘prisoners’ from the vehicle in they were being transferred to a high security jail, who then find themselves in a total unfamiliar location. Fortunately, mystery sponsors of the escape left instructions and survival kits. From this point, history can be made...

DESCRIPTION

The Great Alcatraz Escape is both huge fun and highly challenging. It can be organized in both snowy or no-snowy conditions. The combination of escape atmosphere, problem-solving and strategic running are engaging and successful elements of this teambuilding activity.

TARGETS

This event has had great feedback; teams appreciate greatly the development of concerted effort in achieving a single goal – the success of their own escape.

KEY ELEMENTS

Collaborative problem-solving; strategy; decision-making; efficiency; motivation and mutual support; a drive to survive.

COMMUNICATION SKILLS IMPROVEMENT

This teambuilding activity provides a selection of carefully-designed communication-focussed events and indoor workshops. These are designed to help participants develop better understanding of management and leadership situations, transferring this back into their personal and professional lives. This is based on challenges from practical settings in which groups compete in activities connected with 'control centre teams' communicating with 'explorer teams'. This themed programme can be run all-year round with various tailored options.

DESCRIPTION

This provision has several components – the first is an outdoor teambuilding activity involving teams divided into 'control' and 'explorer' groups, connected by phone/radio. The second is an indoor workshop building on the practical activity, supporting development of deeper skills in communication and interaction.

This well-structured set of challenges helps improve the perennial problem of effective communication between colleagues and departments, sensitizing them to the impediments to communication and the need for effective strategies. The activity gives an excellent underpinning for enhanced communication.
